

WEATHER ADVISORY - TROPICAL STORM KONG-REY 01W

Emergency Management Office (EMO), Office of the Governor has issued the following weather advisory:

APRIL 02, 2007, 5:30 A.M.

HERE IS THE LATEST INFORMATION ON TROPICAL STORM KONG REY 01W AS RECEIVED FROM THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE, TIYAN, GUAM, AND COMPILED AT THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OFFICE, OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR.

AS OF 5:00 AM THIS MORNING, TROPICAL STORM KONG-REY 01W WAS LOCATED NEAR LATITUDE 10.9 DEGREES NORTH AND LONGITUDE 150.7 DEGREES EAST, OR ABOUT 445 MILES SOUTHEAST OF SAIPAN AND TINIAN AND 435 MILES EAST SOUTHEAST OF ROTA. TROPICAL STORM KONG-REY IS MOVING NORTHWEST AT AN AVERAGE 10 MILES PER HOUR WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 65 MILES PER HOUR.
